

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GARNAVILLO, IOWA, BY AMENDING WATER AND SEWER RATES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTIONS MODIFIED. Chapters 92.02 and 99.07 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa, are repealed and the following sections adopted in lieu thereof effective 7/1/2014:

92.02 RATES FOR SERVICE. Water will be furnished at the following rates within the City. The minimum base charge for the first 1,500 gallons per month shall be \$32.52. All gallons over 1,500 shall pay a rate of \$.00454 per gallon. On or before the 1st day of March of each year, the City Clerk shall compute an adjustment to the water rates based upon the multiplication of the current rate by a factor equal to the increase in the Consumer Price Index (C.P.I.) as established by the Federal Government for the preceding twelve (12) month period of January 1 through December 31. This adjustment shall be submitted to the City Council at the first Council Meeting in March. This increase shall go into effect on the succeeding 1st day of July unless otherwise ordered by the City Council.

99.07 RATES FOR SERVICE. The minimum base charge for the first 1,500 gallons per month shall be \$35.87. In addition, each contributor shall pay a user charge for usage in excess of 1,500 gallons per month at the rate of \$.00464 per gallon.

SECTION 2. SECTIONS MODIFIED. Chapters 92.02 and 99.07 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa, are repealed and the following sections adopted in lieu thereof effective 1/1/2015:


92.02 RATES FOR SERVICE. Water will be furnished at the following rates within the City. The minimum base charge for the first 1,500 gallons per month shall be \$33.19. All gallons over 1,500 shall pay a rate of \$.00463 per gallon. On or before the 1st day of March of each year, the City Clerk shall compute an adjustment to the water rates based upon the multiplication of the current rate by a factor equal to the increase in the Consumer Price Index (C.P.I.) as established by the Federal Government for the preceding twelve (12) month period of January 1 through December 31. This adjustment shall be submitted to the City Council at the first Council Meeting in March. This increase shall go into effect on the succeeding 1st day of July unless otherwise ordered by the City Council.

99.07 RATES FOR SERVICE. The minimum base charge for the first 1,500 gallons per month shall be \$36.57. In addition, each contributor shall pay a user charge for usage in excess of 1,500 gallons per month at the rate of \$.00473 per gallon.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. Section 1 of this ordinance shall go into effect on July 1, 2014. Section 2 of this ordinance shall go into effect January 1, 2015. This ordinance was passed, approved, and posted according to the law.

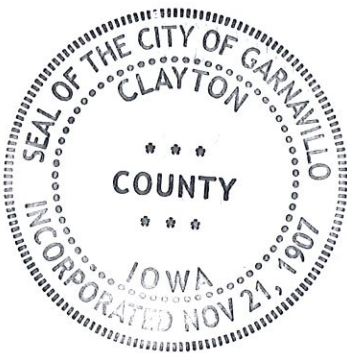

ORDINANCE NO. 07-2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GARNAVILLO, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO THE LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTIONS MODIFIED. Chapters 21.02 and 21.03, and 21.04 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa, are repealed and the following sections adopted in lieu thereof:

21.02 LIBRARY TRUSTEES. The Board of Trustees of the Library, hereinafter referred to as the Board, consists of three (3) resident members and two (2) nonresident members. All resident members are to be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Council. The nonresident members are to be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the County Board of Supervisors.

21.03 QUALIFICATIONS OF TRUSTEES. All resident members of the Board shall be bona fide citizens and residents of the City. The nonresident members of the Board shall be bona fide citizens and residents of the unincorporated County. Members shall be over the age of eighteen (18) years.


21.04 ORGANIZATION OF THE BOARD. The organization of the Board shall be as follows:

1. Term of Office. All appointments to the Board shall be for six (6) years, except to fill vacancies. Each term shall commence on July first. Appointments shall be made every two (2) years of one-third (1/3) the total number or as near as possible, to stagger the terms.
2. Vacancies. The position of any resident Trustee shall be vacated if such member moves permanently from the City. The position of a nonresident Trustee shall be vacated if such member moves permanently from the County or into the City. The position of any Trustee shall be deemed vacated if such member is absent from six (6) consecutive regular meetings of the Board, except in the case of sickness or temporary absence from the City or County. Vacancies in the Board shall be filled in the same manner as an original appointment except that the new Trustee shall fill out the unexpired term for which the appointment is made.
3. Compensation. Trustees shall receive no compensation for their services.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall go into effect on January 1, 2014. This ordinance was passed, approved, and published according to the law.

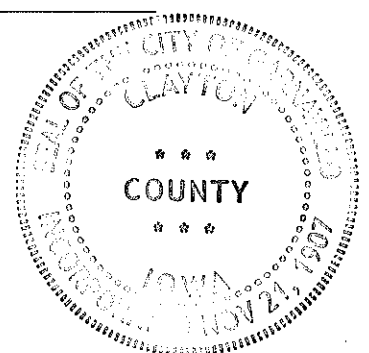
