

ORDINANCE NO. 05-2015**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GARNAVILLO, IOWA, BY ESTABLISHING A TRUCK ROUTE**

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION INSERTED. Chapter 66 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa is amended by inserting the following section.

66.05 TRUCK ROUTE. Truck route regulations are established as follows:

1. Truck Routes Designated. Every motor vehicle weighing five (5) tons or more, when loaded or empty, having no fixed terminal within the City or making no scheduled or definite stops within the City for the purpose of loading or unloading, shall travel over or upon the following streets within the City and none other:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.473)

- A. Industrial Road for its entire length;
 - B. Lincoln Street for its entire length;
 - C. Main Street for its entire length;
 - D. Clayton Street from Adams Street to Lincoln Street;
 - E. Oak Street from Main Street to Houston Street;
 - F. Chestnut Street from Main Street to Houston Street;
 - G. Monroe Street from Clayton Street to Van Buren Street;
 - H. East Van Buren Street from Main Street to the City Limits;
 - I. Oak Street from Washington Street to Main Street;
 - J. Chestnut Street from Washington Street to Main Street;
2. Resident Exception. Residents whose occupation requires the storage of vehicles weighing over five (5) tons may travel the most direct route to their property to store their motor vehicle, however; motor vehicles shall be stored off the city right-of-way, unless special permission has been obtained under section 69.11(2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Garnavillo, Iowa.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
