**Regular Council Meeting Minutes**  
**January 10, 2018 @ 7:00 p.m.**  
**City Hall Meeting Room**

Mayor Priebe called the meeting to order with Dietrich, Kuehl, Downey, Bodish & Mueller present. The Mayor led the pledge of allegiance. Others present were Chad Schroyer, Bryson Schroyer, Elizabeth Jaster, Anne Kruse, Steve Trumblee, Bill Robinson, Austin Coon, Melissa Stocks, Craig Harbaugh and Wade Helle. Council reviewed consent agenda including 12/13/17, 12/20/17 & 1/2/18 minutes, bills & claims, and financial reports. Motion by Bodish, second by Downey to approve the consent agenda. All ayes, motion carried.

Council revisited banking services provider. Clerk to prepare scenarios and provide to banks, put on February agenda. Motion by Bodish, second by Dietrich to approve **Resolution No 2018-01 Authorizing Official Appointments**. Roll call vote ayes: Kuehl, Downey, Bodish, Mueller & Dietrich, motion carried. Motion by Bodish, second by Downey to approve **Resolution No 2018-02 Adopting Employee Handbook**. Roll call vote ayes: Downey, Bodish, Mueller, Dietrich, & Kuehl, motion carried. Motion by Kuehl, second by Dietrich to approve **Resolution No 2018-03 Approving Annual Examination**. Roll call vote ayes: Bodish, Mueller, Dietrich, Kuehl & Downey, motion carried. Council discussed displeasure in having employment contracts for employees.

Motion by Kuehl, second by Dietrich to approve the second reading of **Ordinance 02-2017 An Ordinance for the Operation of Snowmobiles, ATV's and UTV's**. Roll call vote ayes: Mueller, Dietrich, Kuehl, Downey, & Bodish, motion carried. Motion by Bodish, second by Downey to waive the third reading of **Ordinance 02-2017**. Roll call vote ayes: Dietrich, Kuehl, Downey, Bodish & Mueller, motion carried. Motion by Downey, second by Kuehl to decline extended service plan on JD tractor. All ayes, motion carried. Motion by Bodish, second by Downey to approve driveway on Clinic property with stipulations of entering the street forward facings, adequate off street parking and written plans and approval prior to installation to address traffic safety concerns. All ayes, motion carried.

Council received updates on nuisance properties. Budget packets will be out in the next week with review on the February agenda. Housing 360 updates were provided. Police Department report was given. Public Works Superintendent, Mayor, Council, & Administrator gave their reports. With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Downey, second by Bodish to adjourn the meeting at 8:34 p.m. All ayes, motion carried.
