
Mayor Priebe called the meeting to order with Dietrich, Kuehl, Downey, Bodish & Meyer present. The Mayor led the pledge of allegiance. Others present were Chad Schroyer, Elizabeth Jaster, John Krayer, Steve Trumblee, Jody Hawkins, Anne Kruse, Roger Balk, Jerry Scheppele, Bob Siegele, Terry Frommelt & Jane Thein. Mayor opened the public hearing on the status of CDBG funds at 7:01 pm. With no comments, the Mayor closed the public hearing at 7:02 pm. Mayor opened the public hearing on the FY16-17 Budget Amendment at 7:02 pm. With no comments, Mayor closed the public hearing at 7:03 pm. Motion by Meyer, second by Kuehl to approve **Resolution No 2017-10 A Resolution Amending the Current Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2017**. Roll call vote ayes: Kuehl, Downey, Bodish, Meyer & Dietrich, motion carried.

Council reviewed consent agenda including 4/12/17 minutes, bills & claims, financial reports, and liquor license renewal for Speede Shop. Motion by Bodish, second by Dietrich to approve the consent agenda. All ayes, motion carried. John Krayer from MSA presented items for Council consideration. Motion by Bodish, second by Meyer to pay the MSA invoice of \$8,433.47, Lift Station Pay App #7 \$32,864.37, and approve Change Order #3. All ayes, motion carried.


Motion by Meyer, second by Downey to approve Jeff Crow completing the storm sewer/culvert/drainage cleanouts at an hourly rate of \$115. All ayes, motion carried. Motion by Bodish, second by Dietrich to approve Historical Society request of \$500 to complete electrical updates in the museum. All ayes, motion carried. Motion by Kuehl, second by Meyer to approve Jody Hawkins request to not replace the sidewalk in front of his property at 309 E Watson. All ayes, motion carried. Jerry Scheppele discussed the complaint involving his neighbor Backes, stating he has offered to pay for any damages numerous times. No action on the matter by Council at this time. Personnel committee to bring wage recommendations to June meeting.

Chief Trumblee gave the department report. Public Works Superintendent, Mayor, Council, & Administrator gave their reports. With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Kuehl, and seconded by Meyer to adjourn the meeting at 8:17 p.m. All ayes, motion carried.
