

SNOW REMOVAL POLICY ~ WHEN YOU SHOULD EXPECT TO SEE THE SNOWPLOWS

When Snow or Ice Control Operations Begin ~ The Public Works Superintendent, City Administrator or Mayor will decide when to begin snow or ice control operations based on the following criteria:

- Icy conditions
- Snow will be removed when:
 - * Accumulations of two (2) inches of snow; the Emergency Routes only will be plowed.
 - * Accumulations reach three (3) inches or more; the entire city will be plowed.
 - * Public Works will clean up and plow appropriate accumulations during normal business hours. Public Works will not work over time unless there is an accumulation of more than 2 inches of snow.
 - * When blowing and drifting of snow seriously affects traffic
- Anytime snowfall is expected to reach or exceed three (3) inches the city will issue a Snow Emergency. This requires all vehicles to be removed from designated Emergency Snow Routes. (see Exhibit A)

EXHIBIT A ~ EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES-PRIORITY STREETS

S Centre St ~ From Main St (Hwy 52) to Corporate Limits N Van Buren St ~ From Main St (Hwy 52) to Corporate Limits
S Oak St ~ From Main St (Hwy 52) to S Clayton St S Clayton St ~ From S Oak St intersection to S Lincoln St
S Lincoln St ~ From S Clayton St to end of street (lagoons) S Industrial St ~ From Main St (Hwy 52) to S Lincoln St intersection

Snow Emergency Notices

Notices will be posted/run on the City's website, Facebook page and TV Channels KCRG and KWVL. The City will declare a 2-day snow emergency to ensure the city streets are sufficiently cleaned. During the snow emergency cars are to park on the even side of the street on the even calendar day and the odd side of the street on the odd calendar day, unless otherwise stated. On streets where parking is prohibited on one side of the street, the City will allow parking on the prohibited side during a snow emergency only. Streets where parking is prohibited on both sides will remain in effect during a snow emergency.

- Failure to remove vehicles from the Emergency Snow Routes while under a Snow Route Parking Emergency may result in a parking ticket being issued or the vehicle may be towed.

Here are a few snow removal tidbits to remember...

ALLEYS ~

Unless otherwise specified alleys are the property owner's responsibility.

DRIVEWAYS ~

Snow placed in driveways by the city plow are the owners responsibility and may not be placed on or pushed across the street.

FIRE HYDRANTS ~

Property Owners are responsible for removal of snow around fire hydrants located in the right-of-way.

MAILBOXES ~

Property Owners are responsible for clearing snow around their mailbox.

SIDEWALKS~

All sidewalks adjacent to private property are the responsibility of the property owner, snow may not be placed on or pushed across the street. Snow removal must be done in a reasonable amount of time.
