Please have your items curbside by 6:00 am

Items Accepted

- Box springs, mattresses, bed frames
- Sofas, tables, chairs, dressers, desks, bookshelves
- Bathroom fixtures, toilets, sinks
- Children's toys
- Paint cans (must be open and dry)
- Outdoor patio furniture, garden tools, gas powered items
(must be fully drained of fuel, oil or hazardous materials)
- Minimal remodeling materials (carpet must be tied in rolls of four feet (4') and must be less than 40 lbs)

Unacceptable Items

- Items on trailers, building materials, excessive remodeling materials
- Roofing, shingles, bricks, concrete
- LP tanks, vehicles or vehicle parts
- Chemicals, hazardous materials, wet paint and items of excessive weight or length
- Yard waste, including trees and branches

Excessive amounts of material may not be taken.

All items must be small enough to be picked up by one person.

All items will be collected at the discretion of Kluesner Sanitation.

Spring Reminders

Duty to Trim Trees: The owner or agent of the abutting property shall keep the trees on, or overhanging the street, trimmed so that all branches will be at least 15 feet above the surface of the street and eight feet (8') above the sidewalks. If the abutting property owner fails to trim the trees, the City may serve notice on the abutting property owner requiring that such action be taken within five (5) days. If such action is not taken within that time, the City may perform the required action and assess the costs against the butting property for collection in the same manner as a property tax.



Fire Hydrant Flushing

PW will begin flushing hydrants in April.

Please note that this may affect the color of your water.

Compost Site

The compost site is available for Garnavillo residents ONLY

Only yard/garden waste may be taken to the site.

Please separate larger items such as brush from leaves and grass and place in the appropriate piles.

Grass and weed height cannot exceed **8 inches** in height
DO NOT mow grass clippings into the street or on the sidewalk.

REMINDER:

THE CITY DOES NOT ALLOW BURNING WITHIN CITY LIMITS, THIS INCLUDES LEAVES.

Annual Golf Cart Permit \$25.00

All drivers must be at least 18 years of age. To register your golf cart you must have the following:

- * Valid Drivers License
- * Proof of insurance



PET REMINDERS

- ◇ It is unlawful for any owner to allow an animal to run at large within the corporate limits of the City.
- ◇ It is unlawful for the owner of an animal to allow or permit such animal to pass upon the premises of another thereby causing damage to, or interference with, the premises.
- ◇ It is unlawful for the owner of a dog to allow or permit such dog to cause serious annoyance or disturbance to any person by frequent and habitual howling, yelping, barking, or otherwise, or by running after or chasing persons, bicycles, automobiles, or other vehicles.

Storm Drains are ONLY for rain!

Grass clippings, leaves and tree limbs, can clog our storm drains and cause street flooding.

Pollutants from your yard and driveways also flow into the storm drains, which contributes to polluting ground water.
