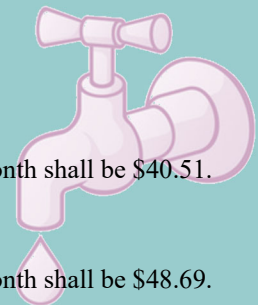
92.02 RATES FOR SERVICE.

1. Water will be furnished at the following rates within the City.

- A. The minimum base charge for the first 1,500 gallons per month shall be \$40.51.
- B. All gallons over 1,500 shall pay a rate of \$.0055 per gallon

99.07 RATES FOR SERVICE.

- A. The minimum base charge for the first 1,500 gallons per month shall be \$48.69.
- B. For all usage in excess of 1,500 shall pay a rate of \$.0056 per gallon.

Curbside Yard Waste Pickup Program

The City of Garnavillo now offers curbside pick up for residents.

The cost of the program is \$5.00 a month April–November.

Contact City Hall for more information and/or to be added to the list.

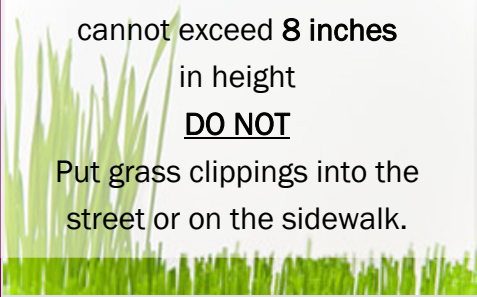
- * Yard waste must be placed in kraft paper bags or a container that can be dumped
- * Each yard waste bag or container cannot weigh more than **50 pounds**
- * All tree trimmings and branches must be bundled with twine and rope and not weigh more than **50 pounds** per bundle
- * Branches must be no longer than **five (5) feet**
- * Branches must be no larger than **six (6) inches** in diameter
- * Bundles should be no more than **18 inches** in diameter

Grass

Grass and weed height cannot exceed **8 inches** in height

DO NOT

Put grass clippings into the street or on the sidewalk.



Storm Drains are ONLY for rain!

- Grass clippings, leaves and tree limbs, can clog our storm drains and cause street flooding.
- Pollutants from your yard and driveways also flow into the storm drains, which contributes to polluting ground water.
- Please be cautious of our community's storm drain system.
